Empowering Young Parents

Many of our clients are first time moms and dads who come to us with very little family or financial support. They often come from broken homes and have little or no understanding of faith in God.

Care Net comes alongside them by enrolling them in our Life Steps and U-Turn programs. Life Steps is an "earn while you learn" one-on-one program that teaches women and couples valuable lessons, such as healthy pregnancy, labor and delivery, and infant care. U-Turn is our men's mentoring program that connects young dads with older, more experienced, Christian men in our community. They meet together every other week for coffee to discuss life and relationships, read an encouraging book, and explore who Jesus is and what God wants for their lives.

These young men and women earn points with every visit and every time they do their "homework" (like going to the doctor, finding employment, or securing housing). They can then spend these points like money in our baby boutique—a beautiful room filled with brand new baby items. They also get a free bundle of diapers and wipes every time they come. But while this material assistance is important, the most valuable thing they gain is knowing <u>God sees them and cares about their journey</u>. And so do we.

Tales from the Center

This past quarter, we received a special visit from a client who had seriously considered abortion at the beginning of her pregnancy; however, after coming to us, she chose life. Now her baby is over a year old, and the cutest thing on the planet! She even managed to finish her degree and is considering volunteering here to help other young women choose life for their babies. She says, "If I could have a baby and still finish school, so can you!"

Last year, I spoke with a young man who was angry that his girlfriend had become pregnant (even though he knew he was the father and was the only one in the relationship who professed to be a believer). He felt it would be best if she got an abortion. If she didn't, he would have to decide whether to "fully commit" or "walk away and have nothing more to do with her." Thankfully, the woman ignored him, fell in love with her baby, and gave birth to a healthy baby girl! And, believe it or not, the young man seems to have reconciled himself to the idea of being a dad and is learning to love his child. Though he hasn't fully committed to them yet, he hasn't walked away, either. Let's keep praying!

We've seen an unusual string of negative pregnancy tests, but we were able to speak to these clients about the risks they're taking and help them consider how they might pursue healthier relationships.

A new, young dad on the mobile unit was so deeply struck by the image of his unborn child on the monitor that he wept. He stood mere inches from the screen to marvel at the life God had created.



Takin' the Mobile Unit to School!

We had the awesome opportunity to take the mobile unit and offer services at the Griz game on Saturday, November 16th! (The Griz vs. Weber State.) We rolled in and set up early to engage with the tailgaters, and we hosted an information table inside the stadium. We were able to offer services and give the students a taste of what we offer at the center every day—LIFE, HEALTH, and HOPE!

In addition to serving students with life-affirming medical resources, we also offer to connect pregnant or parenting students with local sponsors (*like you*) to support and encourage them during the year.
