Do We Get to Find Out How Much We Donated?

Yes! There are two ways to find out the final count so you can report back to the participating church or organization.

The first way is to simply take all the filled bottles to your bank and deposit the cash into your account, then write a check to us for the total amount. Add that number to the total from the checks you receive that were made out to us.

The second way is to bring all the filled bottles to us. We will run the change through our coin-counting machine and email you the total. (This may take a little longer, though, since we utilize teams of volunteers to do it.)

What Is Life Net?

Life Net is the umbrella organization under which Care Net Pregnancy Support Center of Missoula falls. Care Net is a Christian, faith-based organization that exists as an alternative to abortion.

Care Net's mission is to assist anyone experiencing an unplanned pregnancy or engaging in risky sexual behaviors. We are committed to supporting women, men, and their families through pregnancy and beyond by providing educational, emotional, spiritual, and material support. We provide this assistance free-of-charge* to anyone in need, regardless of their personal history or religious beliefs. We provide compassionate, non-judgmental care with the utmost level of confidentiality.

Our services include pregnancy tests, limited ultrasounds, STI testing, material assistance, parenting education and support, men's mentoring, post-abortion counseling, and referrals to outside agencies.

* Though our services are free, certain STI tests do carry a low lab fee which is passed on to clients.

How Does It Work?

Each year, Life Net of Missoula (Care Net) launches a baby bottle drive that runs Mother's Day through Father's Day or between dates your church specifies.

Churches let us know how many baby bottles they would like to receive, and they either pick them up from our office or we deliver them. The churches set up a table (typically in the foyer area) where children and families can take home an empty baby bottle and bring it back filled with change and cash money. (We also accept checks made out to Life Net of Missoula or Care Net of Missoula.)

We recommend that you have the bottles available starting on Mother's Day and request that they be returned to you by Father's Day. (However, if there is a conflict with that scheduling, please feel free to put it off until the following month.) After that time, if you are able to drop off the bottles to us, that would be another incredible (*and very much appreciated!*) way you can serve. Otherwise, we would be happy to come pick up all remaining bottles, both the full ones and the empty ones.
